

FOR THE JOURNAL N. 28

TITLE: Old age and the ageing process. A psychoanalytic perspective from the intersubjective links of couple and family.

The aim of issue 28 of the AICPF journal, which will come out in July 2023, is to approach old age and the ageing process from a psychoanalytic point of view, to provide original reflections and viewpoints on this universal and complex process. It is aimed primarily at couple and family therapists when dealing with older subjects, or when their patients are facing the senescence of their parents. It is also intended to be of interest to any caregiver whose practice leads them to encounter older people, either individually or as a family. To this end, papers based on theoretical or clinical contributions, including those from related sciences (sociology, demography, etc.), are invited. This issue, coordinated by Dr Anne Loncan, Irma Morosini and Dr Alejandro Klein, will be published in July 2023. Articles in English, French and Spanish are due by 15 April 2023.
